POLICY FOR TRAVELLING STOCK IN GRENFELL (NO. 2.3.3)

1. **Title:** Policy for Travelling Stock in Grenfell
2. **Number:** Policy Number 2.3.3
3. **Purpose:**
The purpose of this policy is to inform the community of the roads and streets in Grenfell and environs which have been approved as routes for travelling stock.
4. **Application**
The policy applies to travelling stock movements on roads and streets in and near the town of Grenfell.
5. **Associated Legislation and Other References**
Rural Lands Protection Act 1998 (as amended)
6. **Policy**
 - i) Persons moving stock on public roads and streets require a permit issued by the relevant Local Land Services (LLS), following the consent of Council.
 - ii) The approved routes for movement of travelling stock in the Grenfell area are as follows:-
 - * Henry Lawson Way (Young Road) via Holy Camp Road to Mary Gilmore Road (Barmedman Road),
 - * Mary Gilmore Way (Barmedman Road) via Holy Camp Road, Abbots Lane, Manganese Road and unnamed road (“Stock Route”) to Mid Western Highway (Forbes Road)
 - * Mid Western Highway (Forbes Road) via North Street, Forbes Street and Bourks Street to Gooloogong Road,
 - * Gooloogong Road via North Street, Fitches Lane and Melyra Street to Adelargo Road, then Mid Western Highway (Cowra Road),
 - * Mid Western Highway (Cowra Road) via Derribong Lane, Quandong Road, railway corridor to Walshes Lane and Henry Lawson Way (Young Road).

The adopted routes are depicted on the accompanying map.
7. **Non-compliance**
Non-compliance with this policy renders the person(s) responsible for the stock liable to legal action under the Rural Lands Protection Act.
8. **Review and Amendment**
 - This policy shall be reviewed at four (4) yearly intervals, to ensure it meets all statutory requirements and the needs of Council.
 - This policy may be amended or cancelled by Council at any time without prior notice or obligation.
9. **Adoption**
 - This policy commences as from the date of adoption by Council, being 16 March 2017 and replaces any previous policy.
