POLICY FOR LEGAL ACTION FOR OUTSTANDING DEBTS (NO. 1.4.5)

- 1. <u>Title:</u> Policy for Legal Action for Outstanding Debts
- 2. <u>Number:</u> Policy Number 1.4.5

3. <u>Purpose:</u>

The purpose of this policy is to set out the procedure for pursuing outstanding debts which may ultimately lead to legal action.

4. <u>Application</u>

The policy applies to all debts of the Council including rates, charges, fees or other monies for kerb and guttering, foot paving, private works, etc.

5. <u>Associated Legislation and Other References</u> Local Government Act, section 695.

6. <u>Policy</u>

- i) debtors are to be advised of the outstanding debt and invited in writing to make arrangements to pay off their debt over an agreed period of time.
- ii) the repayment amount may include statutory interest.
- iii) if the debtor has not responded, at least two reminders are to be forwarded at no sooner than fortnightly intervals.
- iv) if the debtor has still not responded within one month of the third (or final) letter, then the debt may be referred for legal action.
- v) every effort shall be made to encourage pensioners to pay off their debts.
- vi) legal action may be terminated at any time provided the debtor makes satisfactory arrangements to pay the debt and any legal costs incurred.
- vii) debts for unpaid rates may be recovered by sale of the property.
- viii) debts may also be recovered from Estates.

7. <u>Non-compliance</u>

Non-compliance with this policy renders the debtor liable for legal action and the additional costs involved, and may include sale of the property for unpaid rates.

8. <u>Review and Amendment</u>

- This policy shall be reviewed at four (4) yearly intervals, to ensure it meets all statutory requirements and the needs of Council.
- This policy may be amended or cancelled by Council at any time without prior notice or obligation to any employee.

9. <u>Adoption</u>

• This policy commences as from the date of adoption by Council, being 16 March 2017 and replaces any previous policy.
