Yes:

Plastics

- All plastics codes 1-7
- Ice cream and takeaway containers
- Milk bottles
- Juice & cream containers
- Cordial bottles



Aluminium & Steel

- All empty steel cans
- Aluminium soft drink cans
- Clean aluminium foil & pie trays
- Empty aerosol cans



Paper and Cardboard

- Telephone directories
- Newspapers & magazines
- Cardboard, cereal & food boxes
- Office paper
- Envelopes & office mail



Glass

- All empty glass bottles & jars



Cartons

- Empty milk & juice cartons



No:

Food scraps



Plastic bags



Polystyrene



Nappy



Crockery



Syringe



Ceramics

PLEASE

- Take lids off containers and drain out any liquids.
- Only items that have held non-hazardous materials can go in the recycling bin. No pool chemicals or pesticides.
- Only place items from the kitchen, bathroom or laundry – never the garden shed or garage – in the recycling bin.
- Look for items in recyclable packaging when at the supermarket and look for ways of reusing items before placing them in the recycling bin.
