Note 1
All relevant pre-construction conditions of the development consent must be satisfied prior to the commencement of work.

Note 2
The Home Building Act 1989 requires that, in the case of building work that involves residential building work (within the meaning of the Home Building Act 1989) the following must be obtained:

(a) in the case of work by a licensee under that Act:
 (i) a statement detailing the licensee's name and contractor licence number, and
 (ii) documentary evidence that the licensee has complied with the applicable requirements of the Act *, or

(b) in the case of work done by any other person:
 (i) a statement detailing the person's name and owner-builder permit number, or
 (ii) a declaration signed by the owner of the land, to the effect that the reasonable market cost of the labour and materials involved in the work is less than the amount prescribed for the purposes of the definition of owner-builder work in section 29 of the Act (currently \$10,000).

* A certificate purporting to be issued by an approved insurer under Part 6 of the Home Building Act 1989 to the effect that a person is a holder of an insurance contract issued for the purposes of the Part, is sufficient evidence that the person has complied with the requirements of the Part.
